The objective of this meeting was to introduce the project to the public, discuss the alternatives being considered, and take questions and comments on the project.

Ken explained the function of UDFCD and gave an overview of the master planning process. He highlighted the importance of water quality in this watershed, as it outfalls into Cherry Creek Reservoir. Melanie and Jim then gave a presentation on the project, including the following topics:

- Watershed overview
- Hydrology update – existing and future impervious conditions
- Problem areas within the watershed
- Priorities considered in development of alternatives
- Summary of Alternatives
- Cost analysis and recommended alternative

Due to the low attendance, there was not a formal question and answer session; instead, the group had an informal discussion of the project. Mr. Mountain, who was representing the Grange located on Lima St. adjacent to the Inverness Regional Pond, did not express any concerns about the project or the recommended alternative. Ron Lambert wanted to make sure that the proposed retrofit to the Inverness Regional Pond would not increase the 100-year water surface – Muller confirmed that the 100-year water surface would not be impacted.
